

# Install Korean font in Raspberry Pi

Run following commands to enable your Raspberry Pi.

```
sudo apt-get install ibus
sudo apt-get install ibus-hangul
sudo apt-get install fonts-unfonts-core
reboot
```

Now you will be able to navigate Korean website like NAVER, DAUM, and etc.

In addition, you will need to run below command for using your Hangul key.

```
sudo apt-get install fcitx-hangul
```

And please follow following procedure to activate all the necessary things:

Raspberry Pi Preference Input Method Click Okay Click Yes Select "fcitx" and click OK OK

Now what you have to do is just rebooting on command line

```
reboot
```
