

# No match for argument: php-mcrypt on CentOS 7

**mcrypt** package is not included in the default CentOS repositories. It can be installed from the Remi repository.

In order to install mcrypt, you need to have root permission.

## STEP 1. Enabling the Remi repository

```
sudo yum install epel-release yum-utils  
sudo yum install http://rpms.remirepo.net/enterprise/remi-release-7.rpm  
sudo yum-config-manager --enable remi
```

## STEP 2. Install the mcrypt package by typing:

```
sudo yum -y install mcrypt php-mcrypt
```
