

No match for argument: php-tidy on CentOS 7

php-tidy package is not included in the default CentOS repositories. It can be installed from the Remi repository.

In order to install Redis, you need to have root permission.

STEP 1. Enabling the **Remi repository**

```
sudo yum install epel-release yum-utils  
sudo yum install http://rpms.remirepo.net/enterprise/remi-release-7.rpm  
sudo yum-config-manager --enable remi
```

STEP 2. Install the Redis package by typing:

```
sudo yum install php-tidy
```
