

# Paste image from clipboard in TinyMCE

You may want copy & paste images just like Microsoft Word - it will be technically pasting from **clipboard** in your system memory. You can simply do it by adding **paste** in plugin and **paste\_as\_text=true, paste\_as\_image=true**.

            resize: 'both'
        });

You may wonder where to store the pasted image, and will found that is pasted as a part of HTML content. It will be something like below:
