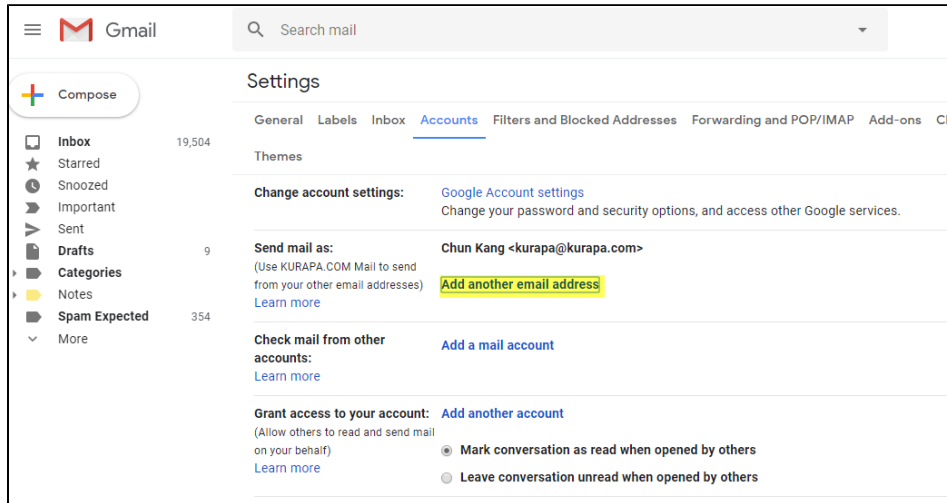


Add New Address to gmail without SMTP (forwarding-only-address)

If you want to use alternative email address instead of your original gmail address, you need to provide details for an SMTP server which will be used to send the mail.

The first action you should do is Settings Accounts Add another email address like below



Then you will see popup window like below

If you have smtp server available, you can use it. Otherwise, please follow below

1. For *SMTP Server*, put smtp.gmail.com
2. For *Username*, your full Gmail address including @gmail.com
Note that you should put your user account including domain name if you use personal domain name like foo.com
3. For *password*, provide an App Password generated in Google Accounts at <https://security.google.com/settings/security/apppasswords>
The first action you should do is put your application name.

How to use it

Go to the settings for your Google Account in the application or device you are trying to set up. Replace your password with the 16-character password shown above. Just like your normal password, this app password grants complete access to your Google Account. You won't need to remember it, so don't write it down or share it with anyone.
